2. Sign Variance Request, Forever Images

Gary Hoover, proprietor of Forever Images asked the Board for a variance to the Sign Ordinance allowing him a wall sign above the door at his business. This variance was needed due to the number of signs already on the premises.

Motion was made by Alderman McCort to grant Mr. Hoovers request and allow him to erect a wall sign as submitted. Motion was seconded by Alderman Walls; motion carried four to one, Alderman Peters opposing.

3. Texas Municipal League Continuation of Coverage Agreement

TML has sent a Continuation of Coverage renewal requiring the Mayor's signature. Motion was made by Alderman Peters to authorize the Mayor to sign the TML Continuation of Coverage document. Motion was seconded by Alderman Fritch; motion carried unanimously.
