The Board of Aldermen meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m. by Mayor Henry.

Mr. De La Rosa explained that there were 63 electric lights that had been installed but did not work. He has spoken with TxDOT regarding the light fixtures and they were not interested in them being returned. He was asking for the board to approve selling these lights. Mayor Henry called for Public Comments. There were none.

Motion made by Mayor Pro Tem Bell to approve the sale of the lights as proposed. Seconded by Alderman Hurst. All approved and motion carried by a vote of four in favor, none opposed.

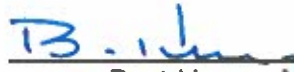
