

ORDINANCE NO. 2020-16

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF SALADO, TEXAS PROVIDING FOR THE ADDITION OF STOP SIGNS AT THE INTERSECTION OF HESTER WAY AND WINNERS CIRCLE, CREATING A THREE- WAY STOP; REPEALING ANY CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND PROVIDING FOR PROPER NOTICE AND MEETING.

WHEREAS, the Village of Salado desires to promote safety, protect its citizens and regulate traffic on village streets; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Texas Local Government Code Chapter 51 the Board of Aldermen has the general authority to adopt and publish an ordinance or police regulation that is for the good government, peace or order of the municipality and is necessary or proper for the carrying out a power granted by law to the municipality; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Texas Transportation Code Chapters 542-546, 553 the Board of Aldermen has the express authority to regulate traffic by traffic-control devices, regulate the operation and movement of vehicles, regulate stopping, standing or parking of vehicles and to enforce such regulations; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen has received reports of the need for a three -way stop signs at the intersection of Hester Way and Winners Circle; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen desires to add three (3) stop signs at the intersection of Hester Way and Winners Circle, creating a three-way stop; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen believes that public safety will be enhanced by regulating traffic at the intersection of Hester Way and Winners Circle.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE VILLAGE OF SALADO, TEXAS:

SECTION 1.01 FINDING OF FACT

The foregoing recitals are incorporated into this Ordinance by reference as findings of fact as if expressly set forth herein.

SECTION 1.02 ENACTMENT

1. The Board of Aldermen hereby approves of the installation of two (2) "Stop Sign" traffic control signs on Hester Way at its intersection with Winners Circle and one (1) "Stop Sign" on Winners Circle at its intersection with Hester Way.
2. The stop signs should be installed at the following locations:

- a. On west bound Hester Way, at the northeast corner of the intersection of Hester Way and Winners Circle *(Between the 2700 and 2600 blocks of Hester Way)*
 - b. On east bound Hester Way, at the southwest corner of the intersection of Hester Way and Winners Circle *(Between the 2700 and 2600 blocks of Hester Way)*
 - c. On south bound Winners Circle, at the northwest corner of the intersection of Winners Circle and Hester Way *(2700 Block of Winners Circle)*
3. The Village Administrator shall install the stop signs at the intersections of Hester Way and Winners Circle as soon as they can be procured.

SECTION 1.03 REPEALER

All Ordinances or parts of ordinances in force, and sections of Ordinances which are inconsistent or in conflict with the terms and provisions contained with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 1.04 SEVERABILITY

It is hereby declared to be the intention of the Board of Aldermen that the phrases, clauses, sentences paragraphs and sections of this Ordinance be severable, and if any phrases, clauses, sentences paragraphs and sections of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences paragraphs and sections of this Ordinance, and the remainder of this Ordinance shall be enforced as written.

SECTION 1.05 EFFECTIVE DATE


This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval and publication, as may be required by law.
